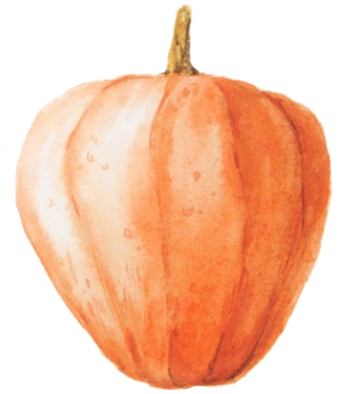


A male turkey is called a tom

The gobble of a turkey can be heard a mile away



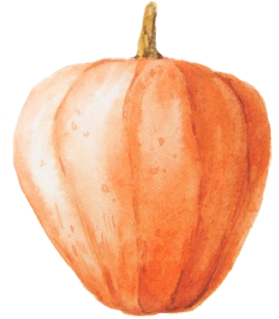
Wild turkeys sleep in trees

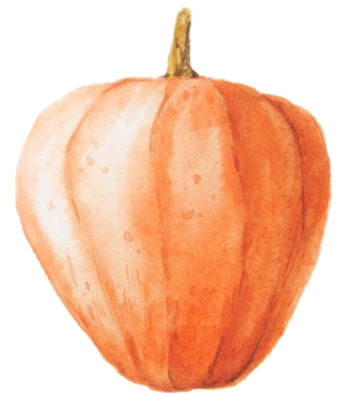
